<p>1) Begin by opening <b>Internet Explorer</b></p>	
<p>2) Select <b>Tools</b> from the menu bar and select <b>Windows Update</b>. If box pops up with request to install, click yes.</p>	
<p>3) If the Windows Update Software is not already installed click <b>Yes</b> for the dialog box that pops up. Otherwise, after it has finished loading, click <b>Scan for updates</b>.</p>	
<p>4) On the left side of the screen, select <b>Critical Updates and Service Packs</b>. Make sure all updates are selected.</p>	
<p>5) Once all updates have been selected, click <b>Review and Install Updates</b>.</p>	

6) Finally, click **Install Now** to begin installing the updates.



It should be noted that these steps may have to be repeated multiple times to ensure that all Critical Updates have been properly installed and it shows 0 updates. Multiple machine reboots may also be necessary.
