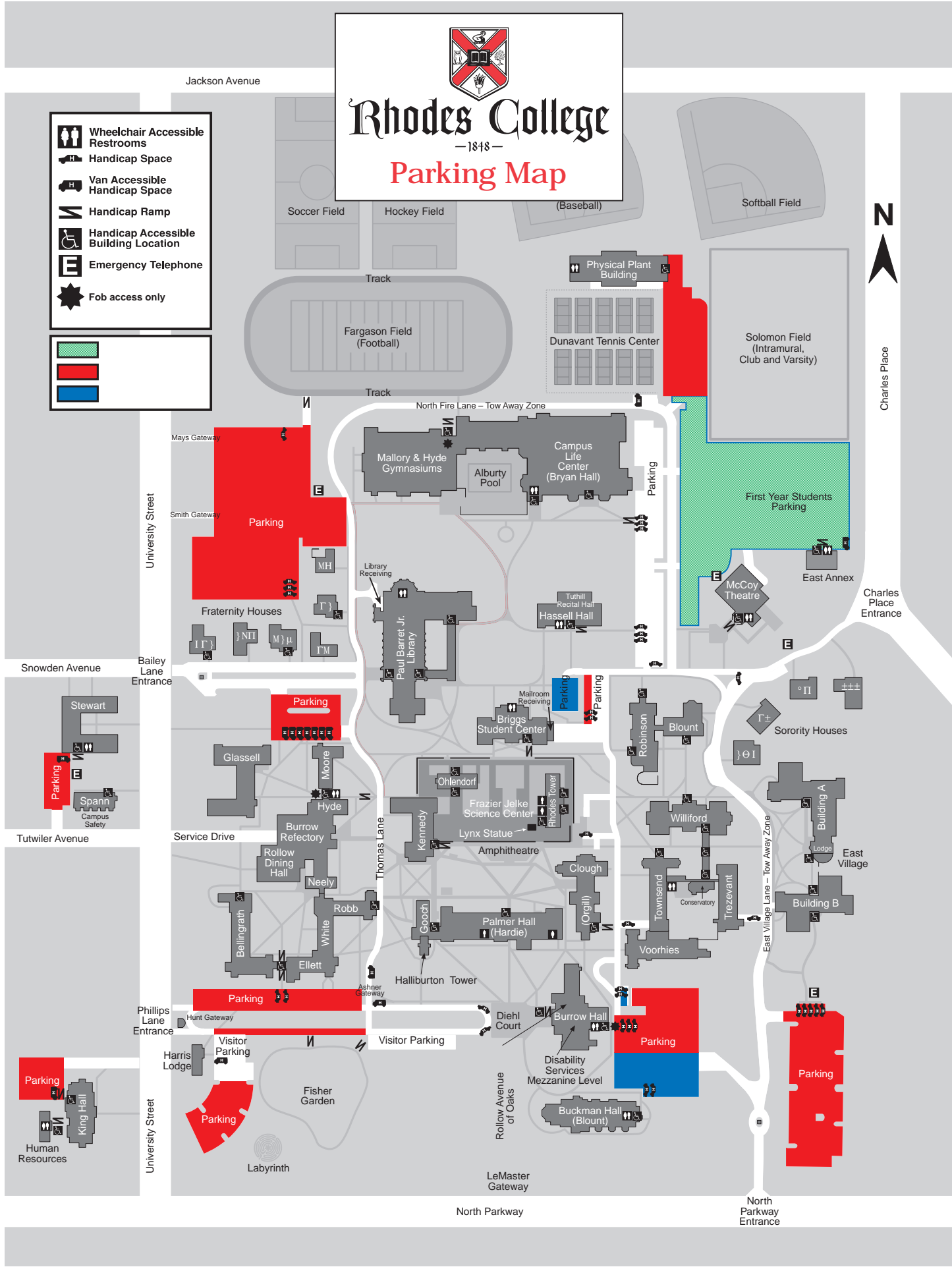
Parking Map

Motor Vehicles on the Rhodes Campus

The Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA), Memphis Fire Protection Laws, and insurance regulations, as well as general safety precautions make parking and traffic control on campus a necessity. Written regulations and appropriate signage are established to facilitate traffic flow, control parking and protect both fire lanes and unloading areas as are designated by law.

Regulations and procedures have been developed for using a motor vehicle on campus. Details are furnished in this brochure and are also published in both the Student handbook and College handbook. If you have questions, please contact the Campus Safety office.

Registration of Motor Vehicles and Fees

All members of the Rhodes community who park on campus are required to register their vehicles with the Campus Safety office. If a member of the Rhodes community drives an unregistered car to campus, it must be registered either permanently or temporarily with the Campus Safety Department. Parking registration fees are prepaid with the student's regular fees. No fee is charged for Faculty or Staff parking permits.

Parking Decals

Decals are both numbered and colored to indicate registration information and specified parking areas and must be affixed to the lower left, inside, driver's side of the front windshield.

Visitor and Reserved Parking

All Visitor and Reserved parking spaces are reserved 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Unauthorized parking will be cited. **This is also a TOW-AWAY ZONE.**

Handicap Parking

Vehicles parked in handicap spaces must display proper placard or license information. Improper or no display of such placard will result in a \$100 fine.

Temporary Handicap status may be acquired by: Student must petition the "Students with Disabilities" Director, Faculty and/or Staff must petition the Director of Human Resources. If approved, Campus Safety will be directed to issue this placard.

Faculty/Staff Designated Parking Lots

These parking lots are reserved for Faculty/Staff only 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

General Regulations

Speeding: The maximum speed limit on campus is 20 mph. Drivers must have their vehicle under control at all times. Speeding and/or the appearance of a lack of control may constitute reckless driving, a misdemeanor under T.C.A. Such incidents may result in the involvement of local police.

Parking along roadways on campus or Fire Lanes: With the exception of move in days, parking along the roadways and curbsides is strictly forbidden. Violators will be ticketed and possibly towed.

D.U.I.: Driving under the influence will not be tolerated as it is a danger to everyone in our campus community. It is strictly prohibited and will result in the involvement of the local police.

Roadways: Driving is permitted only on designated surfaced drives. No vehicle is allowed on the grass, lawns or fields without proper authorization.

Officer Directives: Officer traffic control directions must be obeyed at all times.

Parking in unmarked spaces: All vehicles must be parked in a designated/lined parking space. There are a sufficient number of spaces to accommodate all vehicles in designated areas. Please plan enough time so that you may locate an appropriate parking spot and avoid a citation.

Off Campus Parking

While parking on campus is recommended, those who park on streets near Rhodes should be aware of restrictions imposed by both the City of Memphis and Rhodes.

Areas restricted by Rhodes are as follows: North side of Snowden west of University; South side of Snowden west of the alley; North side of Tutwiler; west of Stewart Parking entrance drive; South side of Tutwiler (unless designated special permit); All perimeter parking around the Evergreen Church property is prohibited.

Note: These restrictions apply to all "members of the Rhodes community" whether your vehicle is registered or not. Violations of these off campus regulations will be strongly enforced.

Appeals

Compliance with parking and traffic control regulations is expected of all persons while driving and/or parking on campus and within jurisdictional areas off campus. Any appeal to this citation must be made within ten (10) calendar days of the date of issue or the right to appeal is forfeited.

To appeal this ticket, submit it along with a written appeal to the Campus Safety Control Center at #5 Spann Building. Appeals will be considered by an appointed panel of students/faculty/staff. The ruling of the appeals committee is final.
