

**AGREEMENT FOR EXCHANGE PROGRAM
BETWEEN RHODES COLLEGE
AND
UNIVERSITAIRE FACULTEITEN SINT - IGNATIUS ANTWERPEN (UFSIA)**

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between Rhodes College and Universitaire Faculteiten Sint - Ignatius Antwerpen (UFSIA).

Article 1: Subject of Agreement

This agreement defines the terms of a student exchange between Rhodes College and Universitaire Faculteiten Sint - Ignatius Antwerpen (UFSIA). Each institution shall accept one (1) student from the other party according to the following guidelines:

- A. Rhodes shall accept one (1) full time UFSIA student for one full academic year.
- B. UFSIA shall accept one (1) full time Rhodes College student for one full academic year.
- C. Either institution may send students for one semester rather than for one full academic year. In this case, two (2) students for one semester shall be equivalent to one student for one full academic year.

The number of student exchanges may be increased to a maximum of five (5) in the following years, the exchanges being carried out on a reciprocal basis.

Article 2: Maintenance of Exchange Balance

An exchange imbalance may be created due to unforeseen circumstances. Any imbalance shall be resolved as follows:

- A. Adjusting the number of students to be exchanged in the following two-year period, unless otherwise agreed upon.
- B. If this agreement is terminated, the institution having the larger number of student semesters to that point shall be entitled to rectify any imbalance within two years from the date in which the agreement is officially terminated.

Article 3: Requirements for Participation

The two institutions shall be responsible for the choice of their students to participate in the exchange, shall ensure that the students selected have sufficient competence in the language of the country to follow the agreed program of instruction and work together to ensure all credits taken will transfer to the home institution.

Article 4: Legal Situation of Exchange Students

The exchange students are subject to the laws of the host country and disciplinary rules of the host institution. Disciplinary actions and sanctions will be determined by the authorities of the host institution.

Article 5: Tuition and Accommodations

Having paid tuition and fees at his/her home institution, each exchange student will be exempt from all tuition and fees at the host institution. Visa, travel accommodations and incidental expenses will be borne by the visiting students. The UFSIA shall arrange accommodations for the students from Rhodes College, the cost of which shall be borne by Rhodes College students. Similar facilities shall be provided by Rhodes College, the cost of which will be borne by UFSIA students.

Article 6: Counseling

Each institution appoints a faculty/staff member to act as an advisor for the exchange students. He/she will advise and assist students in their academic pursuits as well as help them solve general problems that exchange students may encounter.

Article 7: Final Report

At the end of the year, each institution submits to the other a report outlining the results of the exchange including student grades/assessment in the form required by the home institution.

Article 8: Health Services

Students must have proof of health insurance which covers them outside of their country.

Article 9: Staff Exchanges and Research

The two institutions shall undertake to consider the possibility of common research programs and of exchange between appropriate members of the academic staff.

Article 10: Modification and Termination

This agreement may be terminated at the end of each academic year by one of the two signatories, provided three months written notice has been given.
