The University of Antwerp at a glance

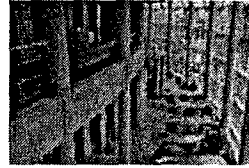
The **University of Antwerp** (UA) is characterised by its high standards in education, internationally competitive research and entrepreneurial approach. It was founded in 2003 after the merger of the three universities that were previously known as **RUCA, UFSIA** and **UIA**, the university's roots go back to 1852. The University of Antwerp has approximately **10.000 students**, which makes it the third largest university in Flanders. Over 1.000 of these students - exchange students not included - are from foreign countries, with a majority of EU countries. In order to face the challenges posed by the internationalization of European education and research, the University is part of **the Antwerp University Association (AUHA)**.

The University of Antwerp has **faculties in Applied Economics, Arts and Philosophy, Law, Medicine, Pharmaceutical - Veterinary and Biomedical Sciences, Political and Social Sciences and Sciences**. The **'Institute of Development Policy and Management'** (IDPM), the **'Universiteit Antwerpen Management School'** (UAMS) and the **'Institute of Transport and Maritime Management Antwerp'** (ITMMA) have an autonomous, faculty-like UA status. Doctoral programmes are available in most faculties.

The **four campuses** are situated in the historic city centre and in the green belt to the south of the city.

IMPORTANT DEADLINES / GENERAL INFORMATION	
APPLICATION	We expect all incoming students (first and second semester) to apply using the ECTS application form. a.s.a.p. but not later than 15 June 2008.
ECTS LEARNING AGREEMENT	To be returned together with the ECTS application form. Upon arrival students may have to revise the learning agreement. Two week add/drop period. Confirmation of the study program two weeks after the start of the semester.

	Request for accommodation form will be sent to all the students nominated for exchange.
INSURANCE	All students are advised to take a travel insurance policy to cover medical expenses, repatriation, loss or theft of property. Students from the European Union and from Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Switzerland are insured during their stay in Belgium through the medical insurance company in their home country. They should bring along a European Health Insurance Card, which can be obtained from the home insurance company (this card replaces the forms E128 or E111). VISA REQUIREMENTS	Students from EU-member states and from Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein and Monaco do not have to fulfill any preliminary formalities before arrival. For stays longer than 3 months, all other nationalities should apply for a student visa to the Belgian diplomatic or consular office of their current place of residence before leaving for Belgium. REGISTRATION AT THE HOST TOWN	For stays of longer than 3 months, all students must register with the town administration office, at the Department of Foreigners ("Dienst Bevolking/Afdeling Vreemdelingen") in the town where they are living, within 8 working days of arrival. Students living in Antwerpen-Wilrijk (post code 2610) or in the city centre (post code 2000), can register through the International Relations Office. At the beginning of each semester the IRO organizes a "registration session".
ESN	Erasmus Student Network (ESN) is an organization for foreign students by home students. They try to find an answer to all your questions and problems and organize all kinds of events. The ESN team consists of students from different universities and Hogescholen in the province of Antwerp. Their home base at University of Antwerp is Room R-009.
