



# RHODES HEALTH SERVICES RECORD

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- The Health Center Record, Medical History Form and Health Insurance Form are to be completed by the incoming student and his/her parents.
- The Physical Examination Report and Immunization Record are to be completed by the physician performing your physical examination and/or your pediatrician.
- The deadline for returning this information to the Rhodes College Student Health Center is June 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Students will not be able to register for classes until this information is received.
- **Physician Appointments** – Schedule your physician appointment upon receiving this form. Physician offices are busy during the summer months.
- **Dates of Immunization** – Contact all previous physicians for dates. Patient files of retired physicians are still available. Contact grade or high schools attended. They have proof of immunizations on file. Contact your local health department if you received your immunizations there. Look for your personal record of immunizations supplied to you by your pediatrician. Pediatricians often give parents a booklet listing immunizations and the dates they were given. If this booklet included the name of the physician and is signed by him/her or the office nurse administering the immunizations, we will accept a copy of this booklet as proof of immunization.
- **Health Insurance** – All Rhodes students are required to have medical insurance coverage while enrolled in the College. Any student needing health insurance may apply through American College Student Association at [www.acsa.com](http://www.acsa.com).
- **International Student's Insurance Coverage** – International Student's insurances coverage will be coordinated by the International Studies Department.
- **Disabilities** – In order to render effective medical care to Rhodes' students, Student Health Services and Disability Services must have an accurate and comprehensive record. Any condition that might affect the student's academic progress or require special attention should be reported. Efforts will be made to carry out or to continue a plan of treatment for the welfare of the student if the personal physician furnishes specific instructions.
