# A PLACE TO LAUNCH YOUR JOURNEY

Our numbers speak for themselves. One year after earning their Rhodes degree, 97% of our graduates are employed, attend graduate school, or volunteer full-time. Their employers include Children's National Hospital, Dell Technologies, Deloitte, Ernst & Young, Fidelity Investments, the French government, KPMG, Mayo Clinic, Inova Health System, Literacy First, Mercer Capital, Morgan Stanley, Mount Sinai Hospital, Oxford University Press, Teach for America, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, the U.S. Army, U.S. House of Representatives, and U.S. Senate, in addition to many others, including schools and law offices across the nation.

Rhodes students far exceed the national average in acceptance into post-graduate health programs. Over the past five years, 318 Rhodes students were accepted into post-graduate health programs with an overall acceptance rate of approximately 81.5%.









### ADMISSION AND SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES

For the past 175 years, we've understood the value of the Rhodes experience—which is why we offer financial aid and scholarship programs that make it possible for qualified students from all walks of life to attend. With our merit-based and need-based financial aid packages, it is not uncommon for the actual out-of-pocket expense of attending Rhodes to be no greater than that of attending a large state university.

#### **Admission Deadlines**

Rhodes practices holistic admission, meaning that our evaluation reviews each student's high school record, test scores (if submitted), written essay, extracurricular activities, and school and teacher recommendations.

#### **Common Application**

The Common Application also serves as the application for Rhodes' merit-based competitive scholarships.

### **Rhodes Merit Scholarships**

Merit awards serve to recognize individual students for their academic talent, service, or leadership achievements. These competitive awards are determined on an individual basis and celebrate the strength and achievements of each admitted student, in and out of the classroom.

## Rhodes has a priority deadline of December 1 for the following merit-based scholarships.

Regardless of application plan (Early Decision I, Early Decision II, Early Action, Regular Decision), applications received by the Office of Admission on or prior to December 1 will be considered for the following merit awards.\*



\* Early Decision (ED) applicants make a commitment to Rhodes as their first-choice institution and agree that, if admitted, they will enroll and withdraw all other applications assuming an adequate financial aid package is provided. Rhodes begins review of ED I applications on Sept. 1 and ED II applications on Nov. 15. Notifications of ED admission decisions are normally sent out twice a month.
