Chinese, French, German, Spanish		Students who earned a 4 or 5 on a language AP exam in Chinese, French, German, or Spanish will receive 4 credits of that language's 201 course by demonstrating proficiency in that language. Proficiency is achieved through placement into a language course at a level above 201 and by approval of the appropriate language faculty. No further language coursework is then required. A student who earned a 4 or 5 on a language AP exam but does not achieve proficiency based on the placement test and faculty approval does not receive any credit for the AP exam and must take an appropriate four-credit language course numbered 201 or higher to earn that credit and proficiency.		
Latin		If a student scored a 4 or 5 on the Latin AP exam and completes Latin 202 (or a more advanced course) with a grade of "B" or higher, the student can be awarded 4 credits (Latin 265) for the AP exam. This awarded credit in Latin 265 may be used toward a major or minor in Ancient Mediterranean Studies. A student must pass the Latin proficiency exam or successfully complete Latin 201 or a more advanced course to fulfill the F10.
