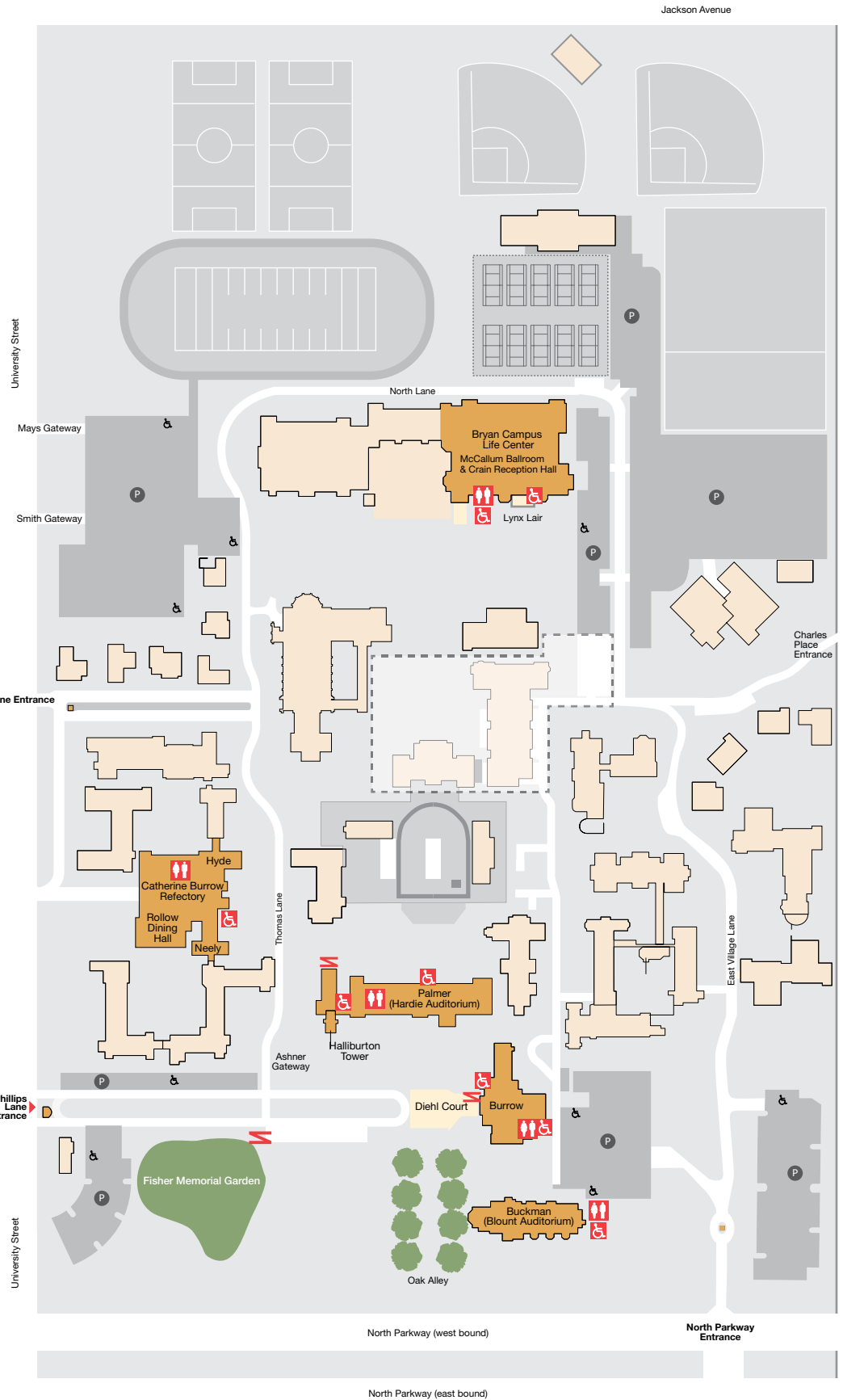

## Tickets for Baccalaureate & Commencement

Seating tickets will be distributed with regalia on May 9 in Hardie Auditorium from 1:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.

### **Baccalaureate 3:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. May 11,**

#### **Bryan Campus Life Center**

Only seniors who participate in the Commencement ceremony will receive four (4) tickets for Baccalaureate, which will be held in the multi-sport courts of the Bryan Campus Life Center. The tickets will be available from Rhodes Express in Burrow Hall starting May 2. Those without tickets can watch the ceremony from the McCallum Ballroom in the Bryan Campus Life Center. The ceremony will also be streamed live from the Rhodes home page, [rhodes.edu](http://rhodes.edu).

### **Commencement 9:30 a.m. - 12:00 noon May 12,**

#### **Fisher Garden**

Only seniors who participate in the Commencement ceremony on May 12 will receive six (6) tickets for seating in Fisher Garden. Those without seating tickets can watch the ceremony in air-conditioned comfort at the following sites:

- The lobby of Burrow Hall
- Hyde Hall in the Catherine Burrow Refectory (dining hall)
- Blount Auditorium in Buckman Hall
- The McCallum Ballroom in the Bryan Campus Life Center
- Streamed live from the Rhodes home page, [rhodes.edu](http://rhodes.edu)

**NOTE:** At the conclusion of the Commencement ceremony, a reception for graduates and their families and friends will be held in Oak Alley. Tickets are not required for this event and all are welcome to attend. In case of rain, the reception will be held in the Catherine Burrow Refectory (dining hall).

## Rain Plan

The May 12 ceremony will be held in Fisher Garden if at all possible. Candidates for graduation, their parents, families, and friends should take precautions if the campus has experienced recent rain conditions by wearing appropriate footwear and having umbrellas handy.

If inclement weather conditions absolutely prevent an outdoor ceremony, a decision to hold the event in the Bryan Campus Life Center will be made by the morning of May 12.

**NOTE:** Only those with seating tickets will be admitted to the rain site in the Bryan Campus Life Center. Four (4) of the six tickets provided for seating in Fisher Garden can be used for seating in the multi-sport courts of the Bryan Campus Life Center. Those without seating tickets can watch the ceremony at the following sites: McCallum Ballroom in the Bryan Campus Life Center; Blount Auditorium in Buckman Hall; the lobby of Burrow Hall; McNeill Concert Hall, West Campus; and Hyde Hall in the Catherine Burrow Refectory (dining hall). The ceremony will also be streamed live from the Rhodes home page ([rhodes.edu](http://rhodes.edu)).
